Consultation on application for electricity distribution and retail licences

Enwave WA Pty Ltd

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Enwave WA Pty Ltd's application for an electricity distribution licence for a microgrid in Peel Business Park and an electricity retail licence to sell electricity to customers connected to the microgrid. Peel Business Park will be an industrial and agribusiness precinct in Nambeelup, 70 kilometres south of Perth.

A summary of the licence application is available on the ERA website.

The grant of the licences is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

• has, and is likely to retain,

or

• will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licences.

The ERA must also have regard to the matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the licence application.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) Monday, 6 January 2020.
