## Benchmark reserve capacity price for the 2022/23 capacity year

**FINAL DECISION** 

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved a revised benchmark reserve capacity price for the 2022/23 capacity year of \$141,900 per megawatt per year, as recommended by the Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO).

The approved revised price for the 2022/23 capacity year will be effective from the date specified in a notice to be published on AEMO's website.

This approval is granted under clause 2.26.1 of the Wholesale Electricity Market Rules on the basis that:

- The revised value for the benchmark reserve capacity price reasonably reflects the application of the method and guiding principles described in clause 4.16 of the market rules.
- AEMO has carried out an adequate public consultation process.

The decision on the benchmark reserve capacity price for the 2022/23 capacity year is available on the ERA <u>website</u>.

The ERA will undertake a review of the method used to calculate the benchmark reserve capacity price in 2020.
