Consultation on electricity retail licence application

FutureGrid Energy

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Future Grid Energy Pty Ltd's (trading as FutureGrid Energy) application for an electricity retail licence to supply electricity to small and large-use business customers within the South West Interconnected System.¹

A summary of the licence application is available on the ERA website.

The grant of the licence is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

- has, and is likely to retain, or
- will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

The ERA must also have regard to the matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the licence application.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) Tuesday, 4 February 2020.
