Proposed revised access arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline

Invitation for public submissions

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on the proposed revised access arrangement for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline (DBNGP), available on the ERA [website](#).

On 2 January 2020, DBNGP (WA) Transmission Pty Ltd (DBP) submitted its proposed revised access arrangement, access arrangement information, and other supporting information to the ERA.

The DBNGP is a transmission pipeline which extends approximately 1,600 kilometres from Dampier in the Pilbara region, through to Perth and Bunbury in the South-West region.

The DBNGP access arrangement sets out the terms and conditions under which DBP will provide third party users access to the DBNGP. The access arrangement information is provided to help interested parties to understand DBP's proposed revisions.

The National Gas Rules require the ERA to publish an initiating notice as soon as practicable after receiving a full access arrangement proposal. This notice is published as an initiating notice in accordance with those requirements.

The ERA will soon publish an issues paper to assist interested parties to prepare submissions on DBP's proposed revisions.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the DBNGP access arrangement proposal.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) Tuesday, 24 March 2020.
