Proposed Western Power Picton South Staged 132kV Conversion

Invitation for public submissions

Western Power has invited submissions on its proposed Picton South staged 132kV conversion. A conversion refers to the upgrading of network assets to increase capacity.

The proposed works involve preparation for the conversion of the network between Picton and Capel to 132kV. Further information about the proposed conversion can be found in the Western Power Options Paper on the <u>ERA website</u>.

As required under Chapter 9 of the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004*, Western Power is required to inform the ERA about major augmentations to its covered network. It must also consult any interested parties.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions to Western Power regarding alternative options or opinions on the proposed augmentation. Western Power will also be hosting two forums for stakeholders, on 17 February 2020 in Perth and 19 February 2020 in Bunbury. Further information can be found on the <u>Western Power website</u>.

Western Power must consider the views and alternative options in the submissions it receives. Western Power will then submit a major augmentation proposal to the ERA for regulatory consideration.
