Consultation on standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Future Grid Energy Pty Ltd's (trading as FutureGrid Energy) proposed <u>standard form contract</u> for the supply of electricity to customers.

On 25 November 2019, FutureGrid Energy applied for an electricity retail licence to supply electricity to small and large-use business customers connected to the South West Interconnected System.¹ A summary of the licence application is available on the <u>ERA</u> website.

Electricity retail licence applicants must submit a draft standard form contract, under which they will supply customers, with their application.

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the requirements of the Act, the relevant regulations, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the electricity retail licence.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the proposed standard form contract.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) Friday, 13 March 2020.
