Consultation on application for electricity distribution licence

Goldfields Power Pty Ltd

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on Goldfields Power Pty Ltd's application for an electricity distribution licence to operate distribution infrastructure from the Parkeston Power Station near Kalgoorlie, Western Australia.

The network comprises of two busbars operating at 33 kilovolts (kV), three 11/33kV step-up transformers, five metered 33kV connection points to Newmont Power's electricity distribution system and an un-metered 33kV connection point to Western Power's electricity transmission network. Metering for the connection point is undertaken by Western Power.

A summary of the <u>licence application</u> is available on the ERA website.

The grant of the licences is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

- has, and is likely to retain, or
- will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licences.

The ERA must also have regard to the matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the Licence application.
