## **Electricity Compliance Reporting Manual 2020**

The Economic Regulation Authority has published an amended Electricity Compliance Reporting Manual to assist licensed electricity providers.

The manual has been updated to identify the licence obligations that apply to small use customers only and the licence obligations that apply only to licensees that operate on the South West Interconnected System.<sup>1</sup> Amendments have also been made to the manual to improve its presentation and clarity.

- Electricity Compliance Reporting Manual 2020 (marked-up version)

The ERA publishes the manual to provide:

- A consolidated list of the compliance obligations relevant to all electricity licensees.
- Categorisation of licence conditions to assist with reporting obligations.
- A self-assessment framework to assist licensees to achieve compliance with licence conditions and report non-compliances to the ERA.
- The format of the reports that licensees must provide to the ERA and the timing of these reports.

Licensees are encouraged to review the changes to the manual and the licence obligations applying to their licence(s).
