Western Power Access Arrangement

Minor amendments to access arrangement

The ERA has approved some minor amendments to Western Power's access arrangement, which was published in February 2019.

When preparing the 2020/21 price list, Western Power found some minor errors in the access arrangement price control formula. These are:

- In clause 5.11.3, the order of the actual and forecast Tariff Equalisation Contribution terms should be reversed and the time period for the second forecast Tariff Equalisation Contribution term should be t-2 rather than t-1.
- The side constraint formula in clause 6.5.13 should include the revenue over/under adjustment for 2018/19 consistent with the 2020/21 maximum target revenue formula.

The ERA considers amendments are required to correct these errors so that the price control is consistent with the ERA's decision on Western Power's access arrangement.

As the amendments are minor and are required to correct errors, the ERA considers that public consultation is not necessary. As required under section 4.42 of the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004*, the ERA considers that the advantages of varying the access arrangement outweigh the disadvantages.

As permitted under section 4.41A of the Access Code, the ERA is publishing this notice to approve the amendments. A copy of the revised access arrangement has been published on the ERA website.
