Decision to renew gas trading licence GTL9 and approve amended standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority has renewed Alinta Sales Pty Ltd's gas trading licence GTL9 and approved its amended standard form contract to sell gas to small use customers in Western Australia.¹

Alinta applied to the ERA on 15 April 2020 to renew GTL9 and to approve its amended standard form contract.

The main changes to the amended standard form contract include:

- Greater clarity about the content of bills.
- Additional information on debt recovery proceedings.
- More information for customers that are having trouble paying their bills.
- Clarifying the conditions applying to the reconnection of supply after it has been disconnected for non-payment of a bill, failing to provide access to the meter or the unauthorised use of gas.

GTL9 has been renewed from 1 July 2020 for 10 years.
