Harvey Water

Licence renewal application

South West Irrigation Management Co-operative Limited (trading as Harvey Water) has applied to the Economic Regulation Authority to renew its <u>water services licence WL31</u>, which expires on 8 October 2021.

Harvey Water has over 1,000 shareholders and other customers. WL31 authorises Harvey Water to provide irrigation and non-potable water supply services to customers in the Waroona, Harvey and Collie River irrigation areas through a network of gravity piping and channels.¹

The ERA may renew a licence if it is satisfied that:

- The applicant has, and is likely to retain, for each class of water service to be authorised
 by the licence, the financial and technical ability to provide the service in the operating
 area or areas to be specified for the service.
- It would not be contrary to the public interest to do so.

The ERA must also have regard to the public interest matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on Harvey Water's request to renew WL31.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) Monday, 3 August 2020.
