# **Blair Fox Energy Retail Pty Ltd**

# 2020 performance audit

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the <u>2020 performance audit report</u> for Blair Fox Energy Retail's electricity retail licence ERL17.

ERL17 authorises Blair Fox Energy Retail to sell electricity to large use customers on the South West Interconnected System.<sup>1</sup>

## The ERA's decision

The ERA considers that Blair Fox Energy Retail has achieved a high level of compliance with its licence.

The ERA has decided to maintain the audit period at 48 months. The next audit will cover the period 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2024, with the report due by 30 June 2024.

#### Background to the ERA's decision

#### Audit ratings

The auditor assessed 69 licence obligations applicable to Blair Fox Energy Retail's licence and found:

- 28 were rated A1 (adequate controls, compliant)
- 41 were rated NP/NR (controls rating not performed, not rated for compliance due to lack of relevant activity).

The audit found no non-compliances.
