Water Supply, Sewerage and Irrigation Performance Data 2015 to 2020

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the <u>consolidated performance data</u> for water supply, sewerage and irrigation services covering 2015 to 2020.

This is the second year that the ERA has published a consolidated set of data for water services. In previous years, separate data was published for water and sewerage supply schemes with 1,000 to 9,999 connections, fewer than 1,000 connections and irrigation services.

Background information

Water licences include a condition requiring licensees to provide performance data to the ERA for each year ending 30 June. The <u>Water, Sewerage and Irrigation Licence Performance</u> <u>Reporting Handbook</u> specifies the data to be provided for each water service.

The data to be provided by each licensee depends on the type of water service and, for water supply and sewerage services, the number of connected properties on the supply network. The ERA only publishes data for water and sewerage supply schemes with less than 10,000 connected properties.

There is a separate national performance reporting framework for water and sewerage supply schemes with more than 10,000 connected properties that is managed by the Bureau of Meteorology.
