Southern Cross Energy Partnership

Invitation for public submissions – Application to amend electricity transmission licence ETL4

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application by TEC Desert Pty Ltd & TEC Desert No.2 Pty Ltd (trading as Southern Cross Energy Partnership) to amend the [operating area](#) of electricity transmission licence [ETL4](#) to include a new point of supply south of Kambalda.¹

Southern Cross was granted ETL4 to build, own and operate a 132kV transmission line in the Goldfields area of Western Australia. The networks are located in a northern area and a southern area. The northern system extending from Mount Keith to Leinster is standalone, while the southern system extending from Kambalda to Kalgoorlie is connected to the South West Interconnected System.

Southern Cross is now seeking to extend the current 66kV transmission line from the Redross Substation, south of Kambalda for a further 4 kilometres in a southerly direction. A new substation will be built at the southernmost point of Southern Cross' network.
