

Rule Change Extension Notice: Method used for the assignment of Certified Reserve Capacity to Intermittent Generators (RC_2019_03)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Market Rules.

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the Rule Change Panel has extended the timeframe for the end of the first submission period for the Rule Change Proposal titled "Method used for the assignment of Certified Reserve Capacity to Intermittent Generators" (RC_2019_03) until **5:00 PM on Thursday 11 February 2021**.

Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process have been adjusted accordingly.

Reason for the Extension

AEMO has requested an extension of five Business Days to the first submission period to allow additional time for AEMO to review the Rule Change Proposal and draft a submission. Therefore, the Rule Change Panel has extended the first submission period until 11 February 2021.

Despite the extension, the Rule Change Panel encourages stakeholders to make their submissions as early as practicable to help the Rule Change Panel to process the Rule Change Proposal as quickly as possible.
