Shire of Gnowangerup

Decision to renew water services licence WL11

The Economic Regulation Authority has renewed the Shire of Gnowangerup's water services licence WL11.

The Shire of Gnowangerup applied to the ERA on 7 December 2020 to renew WL11, which was due to expire on 28 April 2021.

The Shire of Gnowangerup provides non-potable water and sewerage services to customers centred on the township of Ongerup, approximately 400km southeast of Perth. As at 30 June 2020, the Shire provided sewerage services to 91 connected properties.¹

As required under section 47(2) of the *Water Services Act 2012* and regulation 10 of the *Water Services Regulations 2013*, this notice sets out the following prescribed information about the water services licence:
