Western Power's application for network control service costs in the Eastern Goldfields

Final determination

The Economic Regulation Authority has published a [final determination](#) to approve \$9.8 million for Western Power's network control service costs in the Eastern Goldfields.

The ERA published a [draft determination](#) for consultation on 4 March 2021. The ERA received one [submission](#) from Western Power.

The costs that the ERA has approved are for Western Power's contract with Synergy to provide back-up electricity from the West Kalgoorlie generators when there is a planned or unplanned outage on the 220 kV transmission line supplying the Eastern Goldfields. The contract ensures that essential service loads and most small use customers in the Eastern Goldfields will continue to receive an electricity supply when there is an outage on the 220 kV transmission line.

The costs will be added to Western Power's target revenue for the next access arrangement period.
