## Electricity Code review 2019 to 2022

### Publication of ECCC Final Review Report

The Economic Regulation Authority recently received the Electricity Code Consultative Committee's (ECCC) *Final Review Report: 2019-22 Review of the Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers*. The ERA has published the [report on its website](#).

The ERA will now consider the report and decide whether to amend the Code in line with the ECCC's recommendations. If the ERA decides to amend the Code, it will refer any proposed amendments back to the ECCC for further advice. The ECCC will undertake public consultation before it provides its advice.

#### Background

The ECCC is a statutory committee established by the ERA to advise it on matters relating to the *Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers*. The ECCC must carry out a review of the Code every two years.

The ECCC consists of four industry members, four members from consumer representative organisations, two government agency representatives and a non-voting chairperson and executive officer.<sup>1</sup>
