Harvey Water

Amendment to water services licence WL31

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved an amendment to the South West Irrigation Co-operative Limited's (trading as Harvey Water) water services licence WL31.

Harvey Water is a co-operative that provides irrigation and non-potable water supply services in the Harvey and Collie areas.

Harvey Water applied to amend its licence and operating area to allow it to supply potable (drinking) and non-potable water to the Kemerton Industrial Park, which is approximately 15 kilometres north-east of Bunbury.

The ERA's <u>decision</u>, amended <u>WL31</u> and plan <u>OWR-OA-178/3(G)</u> (irrigation and non-potable water), and new plan <u>OWR-OA-315(A)</u> (potable water) are available on the ERA website.

As required by section 47(2) of the *Water Services Act 2012* and regulation 10 of the *Water Services Regulations 2013*, this notice sets out the following prescribed information about the water services licence:
