Busselton Water Corporation

Decision to renew water services licence WL3

The Economic Regulation Authority has renewed Busselton Water Corporation's water service licence WL3.

Busselton Water applied to the ERA on 26 March 2021 to renew WL3, which was due to expire on 30 September 2021.

Busselton Water is a State-owned corporation that provides potable water services in the Busselton, Capel and Blackwood groundwater areas, including a 2 kilometre offshore zone.

Busselton Water has a 330 kilometre distribution network that supplies 12,680 residential properties and 1,020 business properties in Busselton, Port Geographe, Siesta Park, Vasse and Wonnerup.¹
