Wesfarmers Kleenheat Gas Pty Ltd

Licence renewal application

Wesfarmers Kleenheat Gas Pty Ltd has applied to the Economic Regulation Authority to renew its gas distribution licence [GDL9](#), which expires on 29 September 2021.

Kleenheat operates four gas distribution systems that supply liquefied petroleum gas to business and residential customers in:

- Albany (Oyster Harbour)
- Leinster
- Margaret River (Riverslea and Rapids Landing).

There are 1,103 customers connected to Kleenheat's gas distribution systems.¹

The ERA invites public comment on Kleenheat's request to renew GDL9.

To renew a licence, the ERA must be satisfied that the licensee:

- has, and is likely to retain,
- or
- will acquire within a reasonable time after the renewal, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

Section 11K of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994* requires that the ERA must not renew a licence unless it is satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so. Section 11H(3) of the Act specifies the matters that the ERA may consider when determining whether a decision would be contrary to the public interest.

The ERA must also have regard to the public interest matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.
