Landfill Gas and Power Pty Ltd

Decision to renew electricity retail licence ERL11

The Economic Regulation Authority has renewed Landfill Gas and Power Pty Ltd's electricity retail licence ERL11.

Landfill Gas and Power's licence allows it to supply electricity to large use business customers within the South West Interconnected System.¹ Landfill Gas and Power does not supply electricity to residential customers.

Landfill Gas and Power extracts gas from three landfill sites within the Perth metropolitan area and converts the gas into renewable electricity using three gas-to-energy power stations located adjacent to the landfill sites.²

Landfill Gas and Power applied to the ERA on 4 May 2021 to renew ERL11, which is due to expire on 29 June 2021.

ERL11 has been renewed from 5 June 2021 for 15 years.

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¹ A large use customer is a customer that consumes more than 160 megawatts of electricity per year.

² Landfill Gas and Power's three power stations are located at Tamala Park (five megawatts), Red Hill (four megawatts) and Kalamunda (one megawatt).
