Decision to renew electricity retail licence ERL10 and approve amended standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority has renewed Perth Energy Pty Ltd's electricity retail licence ERL10 and approved its amended standard form contract.

Perth Energy supplies electricity to small use and large use business customers through the South West Interconnected System.¹ Perth Energy does not supply electricity to residential customers.

Perth Energy applied to the ERA on 7 April 2021 to renew ERL10, which was due to expire on 29 June 2021, and to approve its amended standard form contract.

ERL10 has been renewed from 25 June 2021 for 15 years.
