Amendments to gas and electricity standard form contracts

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved minor amendments to Alinta Sales Pty Ltd's (trading as Alinta Energy) <u>gas</u> and <u>electricity</u> standard form contracts. The amendments consisted of a change to the opening hours of Alinta Energy's contact centre.

Alinta Energy holds gas trading licence GTL9 and electricity retail licence ERL6 to sell gas and electricity to small use customers.¹

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994* and the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the requirements of the relevant Act or regulations, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the relevant licence.

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¹ GTL9 authorises the sale of gas to small use customers located within the Coastal Supply Area. A small use gas customer is a customer who consumes less than 1 terajoule of gas per year. ERL6 authorises the sale of electricity to small use customers located within the South West Interconnected System. A small use electricity customer is a customer who consumes no more than 160 megawatt hours of electricity per year.
