Decision to renew water services licence WL23 and approve financial hardship policy

The Economic Regulation Authority has renewed the Shire of Moora's water services licence WL23 and has approved the Shire's financial hardship policy.

The Shire applied to the ERA on 17 March 2021 to renew WL23, which was due to expire on 28 April 2021. The Shire holds a water services licence to provide sewerage and non-potable water services to an operating area that is centred on the township of Moora, approximately 170 kilometres north of Perth.

In April 2016, the Shire was exempted from the licence for a period of five years under the *Class Exemption for Small Local Government Sewerage and/or Non-potable Water Services Providers.* The exemption has been subsequently updated, so that the current version expires on 25 May 2022.
