Proposed metering documents submitted by Peel Renewable Energy

Extension of time

The Economic Regulation Authority has extended the deadline to make a decision on <u>an application</u> <u>from Peel Renewable Energy</u> for approval of a proposed model service level agreement, a metrology procedure and a registration process for metering installation providers.

The ERA has extended the deadline from 31 January 2022 to 28 February 2022, as Peel Energy has requested additional time to provide some amendments and corrections to its metering documents.

Peel Renewable Energy is the licenced distribution network service provider for the Peel Business Park Microgrid, located at Nambeelup.

The documents are required under the *Electricity Industry (Metering) Code 2012*. The model service level agreement details the metering services that a network operator must provide and the terms and conditions, including applicable charges. The metrology procedure provides guidance on the provision, installation and maintenance of metering equipment connected to the network. The registration process specifies the criteria that the network operator will take into account when considering an application for registration and authorising the work that may be undertaken.

The extension is permitted under section 6.13(2) of the Metering Code.
