Electricity Compliance Reporting Manual 2022

The Economic Regulation Authority has published an amended Electricity Compliance Reporting Manual to assist licensed electricity providers to understand and comply with their licence obligations.

The manual has been updated to incorporate new obligations under the *Electricity Industry Regulations Amendment (Stand-Alone Power Systems) Regulations 2021* and *Electricity Industry (Metering) Amendment Code 2021*, and to identify the licence obligations that apply only to licensees that operate on the South West Interconnected Network. Amendments have also been made to the manual to improve clarity.

The ERA publishes the manual to provide:

- A consolidated list of the compliance obligations relevant to all electricity licensees.
- Categorisation of licence conditions to assist with reporting obligations.
- A self-assessment framework to assist licensees to achieve compliance with licence conditions and report non-compliances to the ERA.
- The format of the reports that licensees must provide to the ERA and the timing of these reports.

Licensees are encouraged to review the changes to the manual and the licence obligations applying to their licence(s).
