## **Perth Power Partnership**

Surrender of electricity generation licence EGL8

Perth Power Partnership has notified the Economic Regulation Authority of its intention to surrender its electricity generation licence EGL8.

The ERA granted EGL8 to Perth Power Partnership on 9 June 2006 to operate the Kwinana Cogeneration Plant, located 40 kilometres south of Perth in the Kwinana industrial area. Perth Power Partnership supplied steam and electricity to the BP Australia Kwinana Oil Refinery and electricity to Synergy under long-term purchase agreements. The licence was due to expire on 8 June 2036.

The plant ceased operation on 30 November 2021 and Perth Power Partnership commenced decommissioning on 1 December 2021.

The surrender of the licence will take effect when the ERA publishes a notice of the surrender in the Western Australian Government Gazette. The ERA will do this as soon as practicable.
