Western Power's fifth access arrangement review

Issues paper

The Economic Regulation Authority has published an <u>issues paper</u> on Western Power's access arrangement proposal for the period 2022/23 to 2026/27.

The issues paper is intended to help inform interested parties about Western Power's proposal, the ERA's review process, and some of the key issues that the ERA will address in its determination.

The issues paper is not an exhaustive review of the content of Western Power's access arrangement proposal, or the matters that the ERA will address in making its determination.

Public forum

The ERA will host a public forum on the proposed access arrangement revisions, which will include presentations by the ERA and Western Power.

The purpose of the forum is to help interested parties understand Western Power's proposal and the ERA's process for considering the proposal. The forum will also provide interested parties an opportunity to ask questions.

The forum will be held online on Friday, 25 March 2022 from 10:00 am to 11:30 am.
