Invitation for public submissions – Application to amend electricity transmission licence ETL4

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application by TEC Desert Pty Ltd & TEC Desert No.2 Pty Ltd (trading as Southern Cross Energy Partnership) to amend the operating area (<u>Leonora/Leinster</u> and <u>Kalgoorlie/Boulder</u>) of electricity transmission licence <u>ETL4</u>.

Southern Cross was granted ETL4 to construct and operate transmission lines in the north and south of the Goldfields. The northern transmission line connects Mount Keith to Leinster, while the southern transmission line connects Kambalda to Kalgoorlie and is also connected to the South West Interconnected System.

Southern Cross has applied to extend the northern transmission line by approximately two kilometres. The extension will connect two new substations: one substation will be located adjacent to the Mt Keith power station and the other will be at the eastern end of the Mt Keith processing site.
