Minor amendment to electricity transmission licence ETL4

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved minor amendments to TEC Desert Pty Ltd and TEC Desert No. 2 Pty Ltd's (trading as Southern Cross Energy Partnership) electricity transmission licence ETL4.

Southern Cross Energy Partnership was granted ETL4 to construct and operate transmission lines in the north and south of the Goldfields. The northern transmission line connects Mount Keith to Leinster, while the southern transmission line connects Kambalda to Kalgoorlie and is also connected to the South West Interconnected System.

The amendment will cover Southern Cross Energy Partnership's extension of the northern transmission line by approximately 2 kilometres to connect two new substations: one adjacent to the Mt Keith power station and the other at the eastern end of the Mt Keith processing site.

The ERA considers the change to the licence to be a minor amendment that does not call for public consultation.
