Northern Star (Power) Pty Ltd

Surrender of electricity distribution licence EDL4 and electricity retail licence ERL9

Northern Star (Power) Pty Ltd has notified the Economic Regulation Authority of its intention to surrender its electricity distribution licence EDL4 and electricity retail licence ERL9.

The ERA granted EDL4 and ERL9 to Newmont Power Pty Ltd on 30 June 2006 to operate a distribution system in the Goldfields region for the purpose of selling electricity to its sole customer, Kalgoorlie Consolidated Gold Mines Pty Ltd.

In February 2021, Kalgoorlie Consolidated Gold Mines became a wholly owned subsidiary of Northern Star. In December 2021, Northern Star purchased the distribution system from Newmont Power that supplies Kalgoorlie Consolidated Gold Mines.¹ As Northern Star is now self-supplying electricity, it does not need a distribution or retail licence under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*.

The surrender of the licences will take effect when the ERA publishes a notice of the surrender in the Western Australian Government Gazette. The ERA will do this as soon as practicable.
