Gas compliance reporting manual 2022

The Economic Regulation Authority has published an amended gas compliance reporting manual to assist gas distribution and trading licensees to understand and comply with their licence obligations.

The ERA publishes this manual to provide:

- A consolidated list of the compliance obligations relevant to all gas licensees.
- Categorisation of licence conditions to assist with reporting obligations.
- A self-assessment framework to assist licensees to comply with licence conditions and report non-compliances to the ERA.
- The format and due dates of the reports that licensees must provide to the ERA.

The manual has been updated to:

- Adopt amendments made to gas licences as part of the gas licence review 2020.¹
- Align the manual with the *Gas Marketing Code of Conduct 2022*.²
- Remove obligations that are not part of the licensing scheme.
- Make the manual consistent with the electricity compliance reporting manual and applicable legislation.

Licensees are encouraged to review the changes to the manual and the licence obligations applying to their licence(s).
