Alinta Cogeneration (Wagerup) Pty Ltd

2022 performance audit and asset management system review

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the 2022 <u>performance audit</u> and <u>asset management system review reports</u> for Alinta Cogeneration (Wagerup) Pty Ltd's electricity generation licence EGL6.

The Wagerup power station is a 380MW open cycle, gas turbine power plant located adjacent to Alcoa of Australia Ltd's (Alcoa) Wagerup refinery, 124 kilometres south of Perth. The power station operates as a peaking power station, supplying electricity to the South West Interconnected System.

The ERA's decision

The ERA considers that Alinta has achieved a high level of compliance with its licence and has an effective asset management system.

The ERA has decided to maintain the audit and review period at 60 months. The next audit and review will cover the period 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2027, with the report due to be provided by 30 September 2027.

Audit and review findings

Audit

The audit did not find any non-compliances or controls deficiencies.

Review

The assessment of the 12 asset management system processes prescribed in the ERA's 2019 Audit and Review Guidelines: Electricity and Gas Licences did not find any asset management system deficiencies.
