Flat Rocks One Wind Farm Pty Ltd

Surrender of electricity generation licence EGL31

Flat Rocks One Wind Farm Pty Ltd has notified the Economic Regulation Authority of its intention to surrender its electricity generation licence EGL31.

Flat Rocks is surrendering its licence because its wind farm has a capacity less than 100 MW. Under clause 3 of the *Electricity Industry Exemption Order 2005*, a person is exempt from requiring a licence for generating works that have a capacity of not more than 100 MW at the connection point.¹

The surrender of the licence will take effect when the ERA publishes a notice of the surrender in the Western Australian Government Gazette. The ERA will do this as soon as practicable.
