Standard form contracts approved for three licensees

AGL Sales Pty Ltd Electricity Generation and Retail Corporation (t/a Synergy) Wesfarmers Kleenheat Gas Pty Ltd

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved minor amendments to the <u>gas</u> and <u>electricity</u> standard form contracts of AGL, Synergy and Kleenheat, respectively. These contracts align with amendments made to the *Energy Coordination (Customer Contracts) Regulations 2004* and *Electricity Industry (Customer Contracts) Regulations 2005*, which were gazetted on 17 June 2022 and took effect on 1 January 2023.

It is a condition of each licence that licensees have ERA-approved standard form contracts.

AGL holds gas trading licence <u>GTL14</u> authorising it to supply gas to small and large use customers.

Synergy holds electricity retail licence <u>ERL1</u> and gas trading licence <u>GTL8</u>, authorising it to sell electricity and gas to small and large use customers.

Kleenheat holds gas trading licence <u>GTL10</u>, and electricity retail licence <u>ERL5</u>, authorising it to sell gas and electricity to small and large use customers.

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994* and *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the ERA must not approve a standard from contact if it considers that the contract does not meet the relevant regulations, the Act any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the relevant licence. The ERA is satisfied that the amended standard form contracts meet these requirements.
