Standard form contract

Perdaman Energy Retail Pty Ltd

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved minor amendments to the electricity [standard form contract of Perdaman Energy](#). The contract aligns with amendments made to the *Electricity Industry (Customer Contracts) Regulations 2005*, which was gazetted on 17 June 2022 and took effect on 1 January 2023.

It is a condition of each licence that licensees have ERA-approved standard form contracts.

Perdaman Energy holds electricity retail licence [ERL31](#), authorising it to supply electricity to small and large use customers on the South West Interconnected System.¹

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers that the contract does not meet the relevant regulations, the Act or any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the relevant licence. The ERA is satisfied that the amended standard form contract meets these requirements.
