2022 asset management system review

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the 2022 [asset management system review report](#) for Esperance Power Station Pty Ltd's gas distribution licence GDL10.

Esperance Power Station's natural gas distribution system supplies 355 residential and business customers in Esperance. The gas for the distribution system is supplied through the Kambalda to Esperance transmission pipeline.

The ERA's decision

The ERA considers that Esperance Power Station has an effective asset management system.

The ERA has decided to maintain the review period at 24 months. The next review will cover the period 1 September 2022 to 31 August 2024, with the report due to be provided by 30 November 2024.

Review findings

The assessment of the 12 asset management system processes prescribed in the ERA's *2019 Audit and Review Guidelines: Electricity and Gas Licences* did not identify any asset management deficiencies.

While Esperance Power Station's performance improved slightly since the 2020 review, the ratings for seven asset management processes only meet the minimum standard of effectiveness (rated B2). Consequently, the ERA decided that the review period should be maintained at 24 months.
