## Approval of amendments to standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved minor amendments to Alinta's <u>gas</u> standard form contract. The amendments align the contract with amendments made to the *Energy Coordination (Customer Contracts) Regulations 2004*, which was gazetted on 17 June 2022 and took effect on 1 January 2023.

A licensee that retails gas to small use customers is required to have an ERA-approved standard form contract.<sup>1</sup>

Alinta holds gas trading licence <u>GTL9</u>, authorising it to sell gas to small use customers in the Coastal, Goldfields-Esperance and Great Southern supply areas of Western Australia.

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*, the ERA must not approve a gas standard form contract if it considers that the contract does not meet the requirements of the *Energy Coordination (Customer Contracts) Regulations 2004*, or will be inconsistent with the Act or any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the licence. The ERA is satisfied that the amended standard form contract meets these requirements.

## **Further information**

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A 'small use customer' is a customer who consumes less than 1 terajoule of gas per year.
