Approval of minor amendment to standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved a minor amendment to Origin Energy's gas standard form contract.

Origin Energy's customers have the option to purchase an 'add-on', which allows them to offset the carbon emissions from their gas supply. The product is certified carbon neutral by Climate Active and is currently called 'Green Gas.' The term will be changed to 'Origin Go Zero Natural Gas' from 30 April 2023.

The standard form contract has been amended to replace the term 'Green Gas' with 'Origin Go Zero Natural Gas'.

A licensee that retails gas to small use customers is required to have an ERA-approved standard form contract.¹

Origin Energy holds gas trading licence GTL13 authorising it to supply gas to small use customers.

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*, the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the requirements of the *Energy Coordination (Customer Contracts) Regulations 2004* or will be inconsistent with the Act or any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the relevant licence. The ERA is satisfied that the amended standard form contract meets these requirements.

¹ A 'small-use gas customer' is a customer who consumes not more than 1 terajoule of gas per year.
