Ocean Reef Renewable Energy Pty Ltd

Decision to grant electricity distribution and retail licences and approve standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority has granted electricity distribution licence EDL9 and electricity retail licence ERL32 to Ocean Reef Renewable Energy Pty Ltd and approved Ocean Reef Renewable's standard form contract.

Ocean Reef Renewable will operate a microgrid at the Ocean Reef Marina, a development located north of Perth in the City of Joondalup, which will supply electricity to commercial and residential customers connected to the microgrid.

As Ocean Reef Renewable will supply electricity to small use customers, it is required to have an ERA-approved standard form contract.¹
