Exemption application – Red Gully Export Gas Pipeline (PL 96)

Your application for an exemption under Part 23 of the *National Gas Rules*, as applied in Western Australia, for the Red Gully Export Gas Pipeline (PL 96) has been assessed by the Economic Regulation Authority (ERA).

The ERA has decided to grant Category 1, 2 and 3 exemptions for the Red Gully Export Gas Pipeline. The exemptions are valid from 21 June 2023 to 30 June 2028.

Red Gully Export Gas Pipeline is exempt from the operation of Division 3 and Division 4 as well as from the obligation to publish information under Division 2 of Part 23 of the *National Gas Rules (WA)*. These exemptions may be varied or revoked at any time, in accordance with provisions in the *National Gas Rules (WA)*.


MinRes Energy must still comply with all other provisions in the *National Gas Rules (WA)* not covered by these exemptions.

As required under Rule 585(8) of the *National Gas Rules (WA)*, please notify the ERA without delay if circumstances change such that the pipeline no longer qualifies for the exemption granted.

The ERA is required to establish, publish and maintain a register of exemptions. Your application will be published on the ERA's [website](#).
