Eglinton Village Energy Pty Ltd

Decision to grant electricity distribution and retail licences and approve standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority has granted electricity distribution licence EDL10 and electricity retail licence ERL33 to Eglinton Village Energy Pty Ltd and approved Eglinton Village Energy's standard form contract.

Eglinton Village Energy will construct and operate a microgrid at Eglinton Village, a residential development located north of Perth in the City of Wanneroo, which will supply electricity to commercial and residential customers connected to the microgrid.

As Eglinton Village Energy will supply electricity to small use customers, it is required to have an ERA-approved standard form contract.¹
