Frequency Co-optimised Essential System Services Offer Price Ceiling

Final determination

The Economic Regulation Authority has published its final determination for the Frequency Cooptimised Essential System Services (FCESS) Offer Price Ceilings to apply from 1 October 2023.

From the commencement of the new Wholesale Electricity Market, the five new FCESS will replace and supplement some of the current ancillary services arrangements. These are:

- Regulation Raise and Lower, which replace the Upwards and Downwards Load Following Services respectively.
- Contingency Reserve Raise and Lower, which replace the Spinning Reserve and Load Rejection Reserve services respectively.
- Rate of Change of Frequency Control Service, which is a new service in the WEM.

From the start of the New WEM Commencement Day, the FCESS Offer Price Ceiling values will be \$300 per megawatt per hour for the Regulation and Contingency Reserve services, and \$300 per megawatt second per hour for the RoCoF Control Service.

The ERA will adjust the FCESS Offer Price Ceilings by escalating the fuel component on a monthly basis from 1 November 2023, and by escalating the non-fuel component on a quarterly basis from 1 January 2024, as per the indexation formula explained in section 4.3 of the final determination report.

From the trading interval starting at 8:00 AM on 1 March 2024, the FCESS Offer Price Ceiling for the RoCoF Control Service will be zero dollar per megawatt second per hour.
