City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder

Approval of amended financial hardship policy

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved the City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder's amended financial hardship policy for water services licence WL4.

The City provides sewerage services to approximately 13,000 properties and non-potable water supply to a small number of large commercial customers and to irrigate its ovals and parks.

The Water Services Code of Conduct (Customer Service Standards) 2018 requires water service licensees that supply drinking water or sewerage services to have an ERA-approved financial hardship policy in place.¹

CKB has amended its policy to:

- Update its definition of financial hardship
- Include information on fees and charges relating to complaints
- Update the City's branding and the policy's formatting.

The ERA considers that the CKB's amended policy meets the requirements of the Code and the ERA's *Financial Hardship Policy Guidelines for Water Licences (June 2018)*.

Further information

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There are two exceptions to this requirement: licensees that only supply non-residential customers, and licensees that supply solely to members.
