Newmont AP Power Pty Ltd

Licence renewal application – invitation for submissions

Newmont AP Power Pty Ltd has applied to the Economic Regulation Authority to renew its electricity retail licence [ERL13](#), which expires on 1 June 2024, for 10 years.

ERL13 authorises Newmont AP Power to supply electricity to large use customers on the South West Interconnected System.¹ Newmont AP has had no customers since its licence was first granted in June 2009.

To renew a licence, the ERA must be satisfied that the licensee has, and is likely to retain, or will acquire within a reasonable time after the renewal, and is then likely to retain, the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

Section 9 of the *Electricity Industry Act 2004* requires that the ERA must not renew a licence unless it is satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so. Section 8(5) of the *Electricity Act*, without limitation, specifies the matters that the ERA must consider.

The ERA must also have regard to the public interest matters set out in section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*, which include the long-term interests of consumers.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the licence renewal application.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) Wednesday, 1 May 2024.
