Electricity Code of Conduct review 2024

Draft decision

The Economic Regulation Authority has published its <u>draft decision</u> to amend the *Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers 2022.*

Our draft decision follows consideration of the 13 recommendations in the Electricity Code Consultative Committee's (ECCC's) Final Review Report.

The ERA has referred the proposed amendments to the ECCC to undertake consultation and provide us with advice. We will consider this advice before making a final decision on amending the Code. The amended Code is expected to apply from 1 January 2025.

Background

The ECCC is a statutory committee established by the ERA to advise it on matters relating to the Code. The ECCC must carry out a review of the Code every two years.

The ECCC consists of four industry members, four members from consumer representative organisations, two government agency representatives and a non-voting chairperson and executive officer. Members are listed on the ERA's <u>website</u>.
