## Public Transport Authority

### Segregation arrangements

The Public Transport Authority (PTA) has submitted its [segregation arrangements](#) to the Economic Regulation Authority, as required by section 29 of the *Railways (Access) Act 1998*.

The Act requires that a railway owner make arrangements to segregate its access-related functions from its other functions, and have appropriate controls and procedures to ensure that the measures in place operate effectively and are complied with. Access-related functions are the functions involved in arranging the provisions of access to railway infrastructure under the Code.

The PTA has made changes to its segregation arrangements, including:

- Updating Code-defined terms, for example “Operator” to “Access Holder”.
- An addition to section 1.2, which states that the segregation arrangements are relevant only to the portion of the Network to which access is requested by Access Seekers.

### Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites interested parties to make submissions on the PTA’s proposed segregation arrangements.

Submissions close 4:00pm (WST) Monday, 9 June 2025.
