End of Suspension of Time for Assessment of Western Power's Revised Proposed Access Arrangement

Pursuant to section 4.68(a) of the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004* (Access Code), on 21 June 2006 the Economic Regulation Authority suspended the deadline for the issue of a Final Decision on Western Power Corporation's proposed Access Arrangement for its South West Interconnected Network.

The Authority received the majority of the information sought from Western Power on 5 July 2006, however some of the information was not forthcoming and an extension to the deadline under section 51 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003* (Act) was provided to Western Power. The new deadline for the information was 4:00pm WST Monday 10 July 2006.

The Authority has received the information sought from Western Power under section 51 of the Act. Consequently, in accordance with section 4.68(b) of the Access Code, the suspension of time for the issue of a Final Decision is ended from 24 July 2006.
