Consultation on proposed amendment to electricity distribution licence

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on the Electricity Networks Corporation's (trading as Western Power) application to amend its electricity distribution licence ELD1. Western Power is proposing to extend its licence area to include a small area in the Mount Holland vicinity. The expanded area would accommodate a communication tower to connect the proposed King Rocks Wind Farm to the South West Interconnected System.

Western Power is a statutory State-owned corporation that builds, operates and maintains the electricity network in the South West Interconnected System.

In May 2025, the ERA granted an electricity generation licence (EGL33) to Synergy that will allow it to build and operate the King Rocks Wind Farm. The ERA's decision is available on its [website](#) and the licence is available with the list of [electricity licensees](#).

The approval of the licence amendment is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so. When considering the amendment, the ERA must also have regard to section 26 of the *Economic Regulation Authority Act 2003*.
